On the platform of socially produced

The platform of "socially produced" will be presented to the public within the framework of the ETC project sopro HU-AT.

Tasks and aims of the platform

- Consultation on social co-production: Negotiation between enterprises/public institutions and social enterprises (linking platform)
- Development of trademark, later on administration of trademark
- International linking and internationalization
- Acquiring members, servicing members
- Public relations
- Working for the foundation of a legal entity/for a permanent, long-standing organizational and legal form
- Safeguarding long-term financing (calculation, budget, fees, public options of financing)

Organization and structure

The sphere of action of this organization to be founded will cover all of Europe. Within the above ETC project, preliminary works will be performed until the suitable form of organization will have been chosen.

Until official founding of this organization, the platform of „socially produced“ will be a voluntary association of all persons and organizations interested in „social production“ (see information in the right column). Through filing a statement of support, the targeted work of this platform within the framework of the above ETC project is facilitated. The supporters receive in return consultation and negotiation services within the framework of the above EU project for creating products and services, which shall be developed and implemented in cooperation with social institutions outside the first labour market.

The steering committee is the central forum of this platform, occupied by all partners of this project, led by lead partner SENEK.

In this steering committee, the decisive challenges and topics will be identified and delegated to working groups (these are provided for a flexible structure of participants according to topics and focus).

Feasible working groups:

- Development of trademark
- Further development of platform
- ETC project sopro HU-AT
- Financing models

The proposals of the working groups will be discussed in the steering committee. Basically, a broad consensus is sought. The steering committee, furthermore, grants an integrative dealing with the topics (institutions participating in the steering committee, see column on the previous page).

In order to facilitate successful work of the steering committee, the institutions participating grant the required continuity of its members and the required competence for decision-making.

This platform has its "administrative seat" at the lead partner SENEK, 3153 Eschenau, Hauptstrasse 23.

Members of the steering committee are entitled to act on behalf of this platform and work for the achievement of the aims of this platform.

Membership

Until the foundation of an organization, there shall only be "supporters of the sopro Working Community" – as individuals and organizations that seek later membership by signing the statement of support, and that mark with a cross their status desired later on.

- **Full member:** Economic enterprises and public institutions intending to set activities in the fields of CSR and sustainability. Social institutions interested in new cooperation and developments. All institutions/companies, which have been and will be consulted by sopro HU-AT.
- **Extraordinary and associate member:** Individuals and organizations intending to support the aims of this platform.

Formalities of membership:

For free (until foundation of a legal entity in 2014), Declaration of accession

- Members will be listed on the website and in official documents
- sopro HU-AT consultation is free of charge for members

Membership of social enterprises will be dealt with separately.

The steering committee is entitled to decline members/supporters.

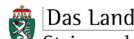
