



Italy: In the framework of the REVES project “Transform” and with the support of the city of Reggio Calabria, five migrant women and an Italian woman founded the co-operative Piccolo Mondo. The co-operative offers a variety of services in particular for (small) children and youngsters. For the city of Reggio Calabria it manages, for instance, a multi-ethnic kindergarten. With its diverse initiatives and implication in a number of local cultural events it also promotes intercultural education and opportunities for parents and youngsters – be they locals or third-country nationals - to meet each other. In 2008, Filipinos, South Americans, Eastern Europeans, Moroccans and Italians were members and/or employees of the co-operative.
