

Finland:



In February 2008, the Finnish social economy structure “Musikcafé After Eight”, in cooperation with the public agency Concordia Jakobstad, started special café evenings called “Café Social”. This initiative concentrates on the life outside the job or the family. It aims to facilitate the creation of a social network for those persons who do not have it. Target groups are both Finnish locals and immigrants who have moved to the region for different reasons. The program of “Café Social” evenings consists of music, games, 'food and culture', film, dance, karaoke and a garden party.
